

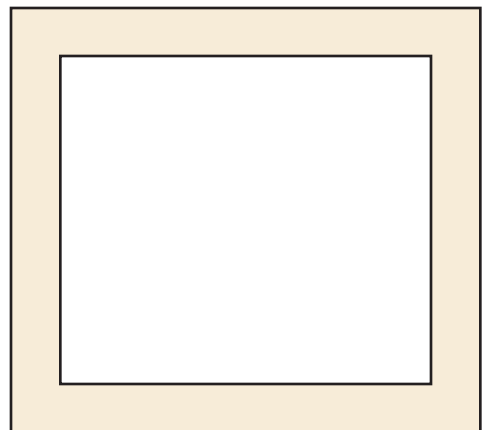


Sheila Shenk Verrips
